1. RULES

- 1.1. Tred Avon Yacht Club (TAYC) is the Organizing authority (OA)
- 1.2. The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.3. All boats shall follow their respective class rules.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1. Sailing Instructions will be on the event website and in the clubhouse prior to the regatta.
- 2.2. The official notice board will be online on the event Notice Board.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to the log canoe class. Three (3) boats are required for a start.
- 3.2. Boats must register online at the TAYC website (www.tayc.com/racing-cal).
- 3.3. Entry closes August 7th at 1900

4. FEES

- 4.1. Entry fees are non-refundable within a week of the regatta.
- 4.2. Entry for the log canoe class is \$55.

5. SCHEDULE

- 5.1. Saturday, Continental breakfast included, the warning signal for the 1st race is 1000. Boats will go back to the docks for lunch. The warning for the 2nd race will be 1400.
- 5.2. Sunday, Continental breakfast included, 1st warning signal at 1000.
- 5.3. Awards will be presented on Sunday afternoon August 9th at Tred Avon Yacht Club, 102 West Strand Oxford, MD 21654. Coat and tie required.

6. THE VENUE

- 6.1. Races will be sailed in the Tred Avon and Choptank Rivers using Government and club drop marks.

7. SCORING

- 7.1. A boat's regatta score shall be the total of all her race scores.
- 7.2. At least one race must be completed to constitute a regatta, three(3) races are scheduled.

8. TROPHIES

- 8.1. Trophies will be given as follows: 1st if 3 boats register, 2nd if 5 register, 3rd if 7 or more register.
- 8.2. The Log Canoe Fleet will be sailing for the *Cutty Sark Trophy*, the *Commodore's Bowl*, *Judge John C. North Trophy*, the *Captain Buck Richardson Trophy*, and the *Douglas Hanks Memorial Trophy*.

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 9.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
